By December of that year, the credit union had 68 members and \$2,105 in deposits. In December 1999, TCU acquired a community charter, extending credit union membership benefits to any California resident who lives, works, worships, or attends school in Alameda, Contra Costa, Colusa, Merced, Napa, Placer, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Solano, Sonoma, Stanislaus, or Yolo County.
