

## What is Access What comes with Access?

This new account has many of the features you'd find in a traditional checking account—but without the hassle of writing checks, recording them in your check register and waiting for them to clear. Plus, you'll avoid the fees that come with insufficient funds in your account to cover those checks.

Instead, Access simplifies your banking. You can do things such as withdraw cash, reserve hotel rooms or cars, pay for gas and other debit card purchases, as long as you have funds in your account.\*

## Who is eligible for Access?

Our Access Account is geared toward young adults who are establishing themselves financially but it is available to anyone looking for an easy-to-manage, tech-focused alternative to traditional checking accounts. Access has none of the limitations of a prepaid card but nearly all of the benefits of a checking account.

With Access, you're automatically enrolled in TCU electronic statements and can enjoy free mobile banking, including our mobile deposit feature that allows you to make paper check deposits using your smartphone. You'll also get free bill payments, free direct deposit and free online banking.

Access account holders have full access to our branches and our Member Service Center for assistance, along with all the other benefits that come from membership at Travis Credit Union.

You can manage your Access account via TCU's iPhone®-or Android®-based mobile phone app. Do all of your banking right in the palm of your hand-held smartphone. How easy is that?
